## CONGRESS XXIII... A NEW FORMAT

**CONGRESS XXIII · HOTEL DEL CORONADO  
OCTOBER 17-20, 2007 · SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA**

Subtle but definite changes have occurred in the format of Congress XXIII. Most significantly, the American Academy of Gnathologic Orthopedics and the International Academy of Gnathology, American Section have co-produced the professional program on Wednesday. This collaboration of gnathologic organizations is loaded with opportunity...for making new friends, sharing ideas and philosophies, and for providing a high-powered continuing education session filled with top-notch essayists.

To maximize available meeting times for both organizations, the schedule of Congress XXIII was changed. Rather than convening the Congress on Wednesday afternoon, a Wednesday morning beginning was required. The closing session, normally Saturday afternoon, was moved to Saturday morning, affording attendees a return home on Saturday afternoon if desired. The IAG's black-tie gala was moved to Friday night to accommodate the Saturday change.

A new philosophy on the professional program was also adopted. Frequently at past Congresses, the presentation times allotted to many speakers was criticized for being too short. 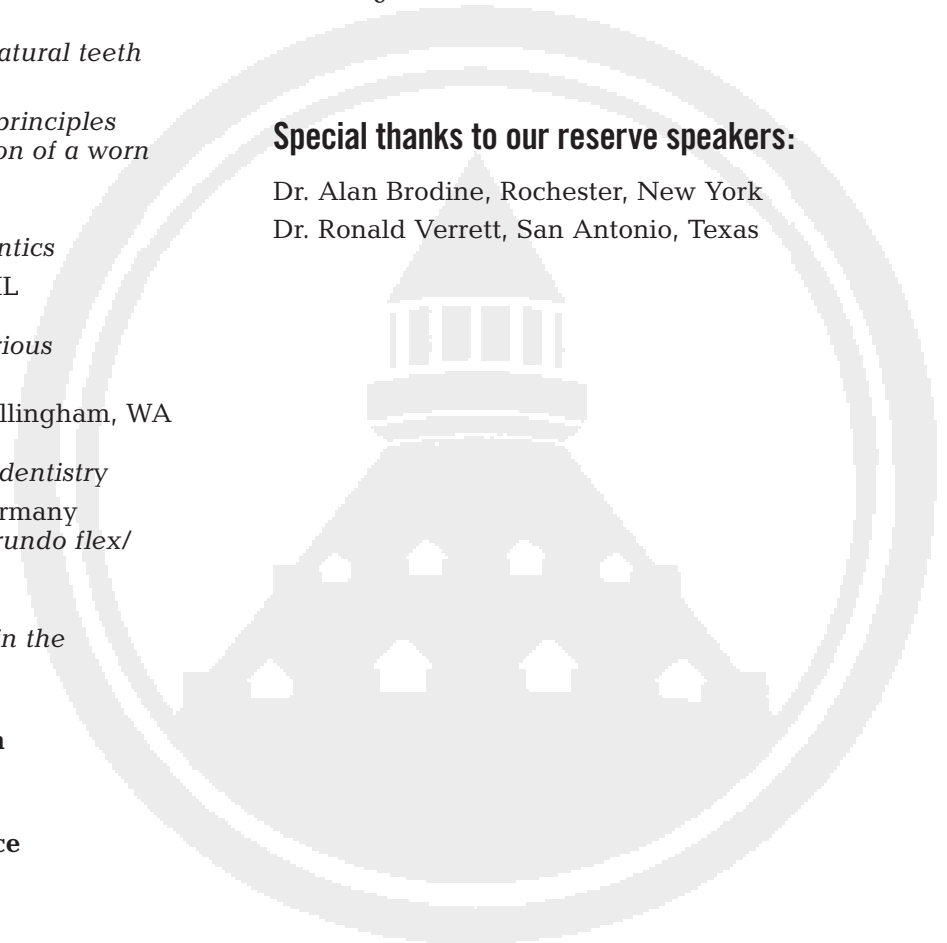
